

↳ How to Install Extension

Once you placed the order you will receive link to download extension package in your email box.

You can also download extension package from your MyAccount > My Downloadable Products Section.

Step 1

Extract downloaded extension package in your magento root folder using FTP(File Transfer Protocol) Tools. For verification of root folder you can see some folders inside magento root folder like app,bin,lib,phpserver and vendor etc.

Step 2

Next Need to run some mageno commands to install extension in your system , so connect with your server via SSH and go to magento root folder (e.g : `cd /var/www/html/magento243`) and run below commands one by one.

- `php bin/magento setup:upgrade`
- `php bin/magento setup:static-content:deploy-f`
- `php bin/magento indexer:reindex`
- `php bin/magento cache:clean`
- `php bin/magento cache:flush`
- `chmod-R 777 var/ pub/ generated/`

Step 3



Step 1
